Class Schedule

Beginning Knitting

Tuesday, September 14th 5:30 pm – 7:30 pm, or
Saturday, October 9th, 2 pm – 4 pm

This class is an Introduction to Continental Knitting and Russian Knitting. If you are an “English” or “throw” style knitter (hold yarn in right hand) and have wanted to learn the “Continental” style of knitting (hold yarn in left hand) – this class is for you! With the Continental style, you will increase your knitting speed and decrease finger and joint pain. Stitches will be even whether knitting or purling. Russian cast on and cast off methods also will be taught. To take this class, you should have the desire learn to knit or open to learning to knit a different way.

Beginning Lace Class

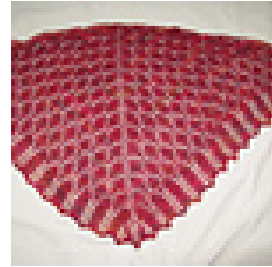


Trinity Shawlette

This class will walk you through the Fiber Trends Felted Clog pattern – from knitting the sole to shaping the upper and seaming everything together at the end. We'll even have a felting party to help you with the felting process if you're unsure about how that works. This is a great pattern that you can knit for years to come. Homework will be required. This class is designed for the advanced beginner knitter.

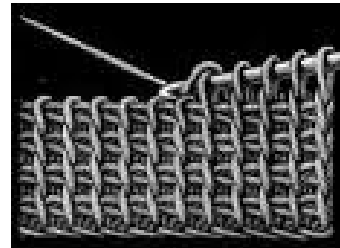
Elizabeth Zimmerman's Baby Surprise Jacket is a tiny knitted wonder. You decrease, you increase, you knit a little more here, you pick up a few stitches there, you bind off, you fold and – surprise! This strange little piece of knitting becomes a jacket. Knit in one solid color or use several colors to make stripes; see what happens with self striping yarns like Noro, JoJo or Mochi +. There are so many ways to approach this little jacket that you can – and many do – knit it again and again each time a new baby arrives. This class is designed for a beginner knitter.



Learn to Tunisian Crochet
