This class will walk you through the Fiber Trends Felted Clog pattern – from knitting the sole to shaping the upper and seaming everything together at the end. We'll even have a felting party to help you with the felting process if you're unsure about how that works. This is a great pattern that you can knit for years to come.

You should: Be able to cast on, knit, purl and bind off. You will learn: Following a written pattern, make one, SSK (slip, slip, knit), wrap & turn, picking up stitches, and three-needle bind-off. You will also learn the valuable skill of reading your knitting!
